1. **Welcome from the Chairman and public session - Ref: 24/72**

A resident enquired about putting a bus stop at Usselby (300 yds down the road from the main bus stop, or alternatively a footpath between Usselby and Osgodby - Cllr Bunney to investigate the possibility and to report back to the Parish Council.

LCC/WLDC Cllr Bunney report:-

There was to be a meeting for parish councils at Market Rasen in Jan 2024 - Cllr Bunney to confirm details nearer the date.

The banking hub in Caistor is being run by the post office, and the Market Rasen hub should be up and running in November 2024.

The new Aldi Supermarket at Market Rasen is due to start building in January 2025 and should be completed in 6 months.

Fir Park - speed restriction queries to reduce from 50mph to 40mph. LCC reluctant to change the speed limit..
