#### 10. Bus Shelter on A46 - Ref: 25/43

Cllr Wilkinson provided photos to show the sight line from the Low Road Junction onto the A46. This was discussed and it was decided to look at the option of moving the bus stop further down the road. Proposed Cllr Trafford. Seconded Cllr Wilkinson. All in favour.

## 11. Dog bin at Kirk Hill - Ref: 25/44

After discussion with WLDC it was decided not to move the bin to the other side of the road as the litter bin further down the road could be incorporated as a dog bin.

## 12. Speeding in the village - Ref: 25/45

Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership suggested the option of the Enforcement side of Community Speed Watch using a speed gun. A minimum of 6 volunteers would be required who would be trained by the Police. The cost of a speed gun and high viz clothing would be about  $\pounds 500 - \pounds 600$ .

This was discussed and was decided to look at the latest speed data and to review the situation.
